Life Membership – a one-off, lump sum payment that allows an individual aged 12 years or over, or a couple living at the same address to join BSAC for life	£1000.00 Single full diving member £500.00 Abated member £1,500.00 Full diving member plus abated member	Includes BSAC Magazine and club voting powers. Lump sum payment can be paid over the first 12 month period in instalments – please contact BSAC HQ membership services for more details
Associate Member – a non-diving category of member	£43.00	Includes BSAC Magazine and club voting powers
Junior Diving Membership – for divers aged between 12 and 17 years	£25.00	Does not include BSAC magazine or club voting powers. Subscription does not reduce according to BSAC diver/instructor grade.
Student, Youth Diving Member – for divers aged 18 years old or over and in full-time education	£25.00	Does not include BSAC magazine or club voting powers. Club Membership Secretary must check for proof of member being in full-time education and, if over the age of 23, submit a photocopy of that student's college details to BSAC HQ with their subscription.
Full Snorkelling Member	£50.00	Includes BSAC magazine and club voting powers
Snorkel Member – available to any individual aged six years or over	£16.00	Does not include BSAC magazine or club voting powers. Snorkel members are not able to scuba dive with their club.

Important notes:

1. Scuba diving is an adventure sport and in order to dive with BSAC, you are required to hold a valid medical certificate. You can download the medical form via BSAC's website (bsac.com). For further details please call BSAC HQ.
2. **Overseas members** – the basic BSAC subscription includes provision for sending the monthly club magazine (DIVE) to all full members of BSAC and one copy to each family membership. These magazines are all sent by surface mail that, for overseas members, may result in a small delay in receipt. Members living outside the UK are therefore able to receive the club magazine by airmail rather than surface mail if the following surplus fees are paid with their subscription:
